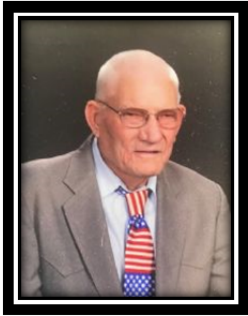


Hugh Emerson Bellmon
