Ronney D. Bradley, 77, passed away on Tuesday, October 16, 2018, in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

Ronney was born in Stillwater, Oklahoma on March 16, 1941, to J. Roy and Minnie Reynolds Bradley. He graduated from Oklahoma Military High School Academy and Oklahoma State University. Ronney was co-owner of Bradley Plumbing and Electric; he was later a Real Estate Broker and Investor and was self-employed all of his working life. Ronney served in the U. S.
