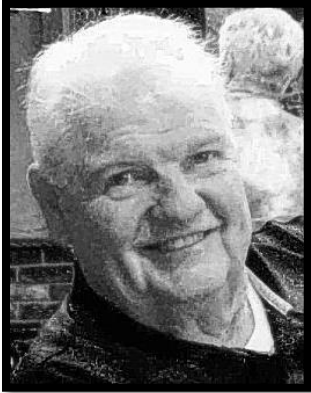


Raymond W Hacker
