Martin Eugene Horinek, 83, died on Tuesday, February 26, 2013 in Stillwater, Oklahoma. A memorial service will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, March 4, 2013 at St. John the Evangelist University Parish with Father Stuart Crevcoure officiating. Strode Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
