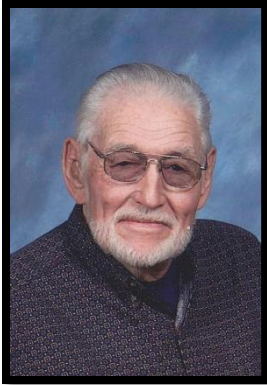


Phillip W. Leininger
