Quinton L. Lyon, 84, passed away Sunday, March 12, 2017, at Stillwater Medical Center, Stillwater, OK. He was born on February 5, 1933, in Skedee, OK, to Wesley Warren Lyon and Lorena (Poos) Lyon.
