

# W. A. Mills Services

## To Be Held Here Friday

W. A. "Willie" Mills, 201 E. 14th, died at Stillwater Municipal Hospital Tuesday, Oct. 24, 1972. He was 76.

Services will be held Friday at 11 a.m. in the Strode Funeral Home Chapel. Burial will be in Roselawn Cemetery at Okeene at 2 p.m.

The son of Milton F. and Hattie E. Mills, he was born May 22, 1896, at Okeene. After serving in World War I, he moved to Stillwater about 1920 and has resided here since that time, except for one year in the early 1920s when he was assistant county agent in Muskogee County.

He was married to Vada Barnes at Ashland, Kan., June

14, 1929. Mills was an employe of the postal department for 35 years.

He had been a Payne County rancher since 1929 and was still engaged in the cattle business at the time of his death. He was a member of the Hanner-Sharp American Legion Post No. 129 and in earlier years had held offices in the Izaac Walton League and the Stillwater Livestock Sales Day Association.

Survivors include a son, Gary of Ashland, and a daughter, Mrs. Kay (Jay R.) Zerfoss, Palo Alto, Calif.; a brother, Russell I. of Springfield, Colo., and four grandchildren.

His wife died Aug. 17, 1944.
