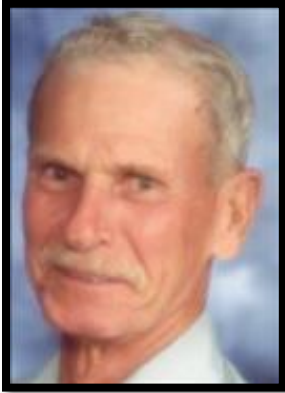


Mack Payne
