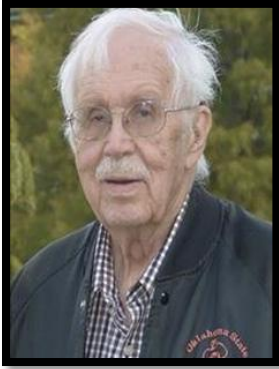


Kenneth Douglas Sandvold



Kenneth Douglas Sandvold, 91, died peacefully of age-related causes on April 26, 2020 in Stillwater, Ok. Strode Funeral Home is handling arrangements. Memorial services to be scheduled at a later time.

He was born May 26, 1928 in Ada, Minnesota to Kenneth and Esther (Lien) Sandvold. After graduating from Twin Valley High School in 1946, he graduated with a B.A. from Concordia College in 1952, awarded a master's degree from The University of North Dakota in 1954, and earned his P.H.D. in Psychology at the University of Illinois in 1962. He served in the U.S. Army

11th Airborne Division in Japan from 1946 to 1948, and again in 1951. Kenneth married his wife Gloria M. (Reardon) Sandvold on July 7, 1951.

Dr. Sandvold was a staff psychologist at North Dakota State Hospital, and interned at the VA hospital in Danville, Illinois. He taught PHD programs in Clinical Psychology at Oklahoma State University from 1965 to 1990. He volunteered for many years with Judith Karmen Hospice as well as many local and state programs. He was member of Salem Lutheran Church in Stillwater for over 50 years. He was an avid singer in the church choir as well as the Stillwater Community Singers.

He is survived by his children, Marie Due and Neil Sandvold; son-in-law, Ron Due; sister, Marilyn Hartman; sister-in-law, Darlene Sandvold; and many nephews and nieces.

He was preceded in death by his brothers, Gerald Sandvold, Clebourne Sandvold; and son-in-law, Mark Robinson.

Kenneth Sandvold was a member of Hanner-Sharp American Legion Post 129 Stillwater for 23 years.
