**Obituary for Robert Delor Sloan**

Robert (Bob) Sloan, 82, passed away peacefully May 3, 2014 at the Veterans Center in Norman, Oklahoma. Funeral services will be held on 10:30 am, Friday, May 9, 2014 at Sunnybrook Christian Church, Stillwater, Oklahoma. Mr. Paul Anderson and Mr. Paul Weece will be officiating. A private family interment will follow. Visitation will be held Wednesday and Thursday at Strode Funeral Home.

Bob was born on July 2, 1931 to James Orville Sloan and Inah M. Chapman in Stillwater, Oklahoma. He attended Fair Plains Elementary School and graduated from Stillwater High School. On June 30, 1952, Bob married the love of his life, Wanda M. Kite. They have had nearly 62 years together. He served his country in the United States Army during the Korean War.

After returning from his military service he worked in oil fields and built house around Stillwater with the Sloan Brothers Construction Company during 1950's. Bob worked as a Union Carpenter and member of the Stillwater Carpenters Union #1686 since 1962, and he was well-known for his ability to build and repair almost anything. He worked on many buildings in and around Stillwater during his career, namely the post office, Colvin Center, various Lewis Stadium remodels, the Pawhuska Fire Station and other buildings across the state.

He was also a member of Sunnybrook Christian Church, the American Legion, the Moose Lodge, and the C.E. Donart Alumni Association where he serviced as a Board Member. Bob traveled extensively with Sunnybrook Christian Church group, the Primetimers, and also helped with various missions in the US and Central American.

Bob is preceded in death by his parents, Orville and Inah Sloan, and was the last

surviving child of ten children; brothers, Lee, Everett, Earnest, Elbert, and Bill Sloan; sisters, Mae Doyle, Delpha Rains, Leona Hall, and Ruby Davis; and his middle son, Scott D. Sloan of Parker CO, who recently passed away.

He is survived by his wife, Wanda Sloan; sons, Randy Sloan of Tulsa, OK and Mark Sloan of Frisco, TX; and grandchildren, Hallie Sloan of Fort Collins, CO, Jessica Sloan of Addison, TX, Alison Sloan of Thornton, CO, Austin Sloan of Norman, OK, Neelie Sloan of Parker, CO, Parker Sloan of Frisco, TX, and Nicholas Sloan of Plano, TX.
